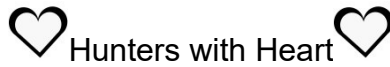

Procedures for the Outfitter

1. Now that you have indicated that you would like to participate in the program, you will be sent your donation package.
2. The donation package will consist of:
 - a) Hunters With Heart Registration forms
 - b) Numbered Tags / Fasteners
 - c) Bags** Please note you will be provided with enough forms/tags etc. for the number of animals you anticipate for donation.
3. You will need one (1) registration form per donation
4. Please scan and email **completed** registration forms to: christine.mcnab@gov.sk.ca or fax to (306)764-2488.
5. Registration forms need to accompany the carcass in transport.
6. Please ensure the meat seal is attached to the carcass. Outfitters are required to leave the tail of the deer attached to the carcass **OR** leave the lower hind leg from the hock joint down with hide still attached to prove/identify species of deer.
7. Animals must be field dressed / skinned / tagged and wrapped in plastic.
8. The head must be double bagged and accompany the donation (body) to send away for Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD). Community Mobilization Prince Albert (CMPA) will be responsible for getting the head tested.
9. Tagging Requirements
 - a) You will receive numbered tags in your package,
 - b) Each tag will tear into two (2) individual tags with the same printed number
 - c) The animal **must be tagged**, head and body with the same tag numbers. This is to ensure we know which head goes with which body.
